2012 Description of the SPE Pittsburgh Petroleum Section Scholarship Program

On September 16, 2009, SPE Pittsburgh Petroleum Section board met and announced scholarship funds of \$15,000 each year for the next four years (2010 – 2013). Six recipients will be chosen annually, each receiving a scholarship in the amount of \$2,500.00. Five of the recipients will be general student members whom apply for the scholarship. The sixth recipient is reserved for a dependent of a SPE professional member in the Pittsburgh Petroleum Section.

To apply for the general scholarship, a student must meet the following requirements:

- Be a SPE member
- Be a full-time undergraduate student
- Must have at least one semester (fall) remaining before graduation
- Be enrolled in petroleum and natural gas engineering or related engineering program at an institution in Pennsylvania with GPA above 3.0
- Plan to work in the petroleum industry. Preference will be given to students with strong backgrounds in petroleum related studies and those whom have demonstrated serious commitment to petroleum engineering
- Submit complete application materials:
 - general application form No. 2
 - school transcripts
 - resume
 - appraisal form
 - a brief description of how applicant became interested in pursuing a career in petroleum engineering or related discipline

To apply for the dependent scholarship, a student must meet the following requirements:

- One of your parent is a professional SPE member in the Pittsburgh Petroleum Section
- Be a full-time undergraduate student in any major (does not have to be related to the petroleum industry)
- Must have at least one semester (fall) remaining before graduation
- Be enrolled in an accredited institution with GPA above 3.0
- Submit complete application materials:
 - dependent application form No. 2b
 - school transcripts
 - resume
 - appraisal form
 - photo copy of SPE member ID

Applications should be received by 5:00pm, March 1st, 2012 as this year's winners will be announced by March 26th, 2012. The scholarships will be awarded in April 2012 at an event and location to be determined. The funds will be awarded directly to the respective students for use in defraying the cost of tuition, books, and/or living expenses.
